LITHIUM-ION BATTERY SAFETY NOW TO RECYCLE BATTERIES





Recycling lithium-ion batteries is the only proper way of disposing the battery. Not recycling lithium-ion batteries can cause fires, and by recycling batteries, the valuable materials in them will be reused. Visit Call2Recycle.org to find a local battery recycling location.



Never place batteries in regular waste and recycling bins. They will likely catch fire.



To prevent fires, tape battery terminals and/or place lithium-ion batteries in a separate bag. Keep batteries segregated from other materials.



Recycling batteries is **good for the environment**, as the materials in the battery can be **reused**.



Putting batteries of any type in the trash **may be illegal** in some states.
