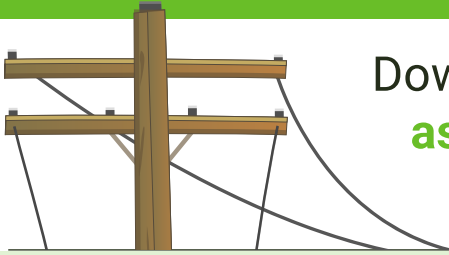




ALWAYS ASSUME POWER LINES ARE LIVE





Downed power lines can be **deadly**. Always **assume a downed power line is live** and avoid approaching them or anything near them.

Use Precaution


1  Downed power lines can energize the ground up to **35 feet** away. Even more in wet conditions.

2  If you see a downed power line, **call 911**.


3  **Never drive over** downed power lines or anything in contact with them.

4  **Never try to move** a downed power line.

Power Line Contact


1  If a vehicle contacts a **power line** or **utility pole**, stay away and call 911.

2  Consider **all lines** to be live and dangerous.

3  Stay in place or inside your vehicle **unless you see fire or smoke**.

4  **Warn others** to stay at least 35 feet away.


5  **Tell others** not to approach the vehicle, downed lines, or anything that may be in contact with the downed lines.

6  Call **911**.

In the Event of Fire or Smoke

1  Do not touch the ground and vehicle **at the same time**.

2  Jump from the vehicle with **your feet together**.

3  **Shuffle** at least 50-70 feet away, or about 6 truck lengths, and **avoid lifting your feet**.
